POLICY INFORMATION

Per the University of St. Thomas Admission Requirements for Non-Degree-Seeking Undergraduate Students:

High school students request approval to take courses at the University of St. Thomas through the Office of Admissions. To be eligible to take courses, students must be a Junior or Senior (or its equivalent) in high school, submit a high school transcript showing a cumulative GPA of 3.5 (weighted if applicable) or higher, have an appropriate school administrator submit a Statement of Support Form and, if less than 18 years of age, have a parent/guardian submit a Parent Consent Form.
