

Can you be an Aquinas Scholar?

To complete the Honors Program you will need to take three Honors Sections and three Honors Seminars. Seminars are usually taken during the junior and senior years, so they do not present a significant obstacle to first- or second-year students who join the program.

Honors Sections, involve general requirements, many of which you will have completed by the end of the current semester. To find out if you have room in your degree, complete the checklist on this page. If you have not taken three or more courses listed, then you can likely complete the requirements of the Honors Program.

Pre-Fall 2020 Curriculum – Projections based on past offerings that fulfill the pre-Fall 2020 curriculum:

History Course

There is an Honors Section of History 114 offered every spring.

Fine Arts

There is an Honors Section of Art History 110 offered each fall.

Second Theology Course

There are Honors Sections of 200-level Theology courses offered each semester.

Second Philosophy Course

There are Honors Sections of Philosophy 214 (Introductory Ethics) offered frequently.

Third Theology Course

There is usually one Honors Section 300-level Theology course offered each semester.

Social Analysis

Psychology 111 General Psychology fulfills this requirement and is offered regularly.

Human Diversity

Theology 331 (World Religions) meets the human diversity requirement

Post-Fall 2020 Curriculum – Likely offerings include:

First English Course

There are Honors Sections of English 19X offered each fall.

First Theology Course

There are Honors Sections of Theology 100 offered every other semester.

First Philosophy Course

There are Honors Sections of Philosophy 197 offered every other semester.

History Course

There is an Honors Section of History 114 offered every spring.

Second Theology Course

There are Honors Sections of 200-level Theology courses offered each semester.

Second Philosophy Course

There are Honors Sections of 200-level Philosophy courses offered frequently.

Social Analysis

Psychology 111 General Psychology fulfills this requirement and is offered regularly.

Engineering

It is likely that ENGR 100 will be offered each fall.

Flagged courses

It is likely that many of the above courses will count as flagged courses. In addition, Seminars are under consideration to be counted toward Integrations in the Humanities.
