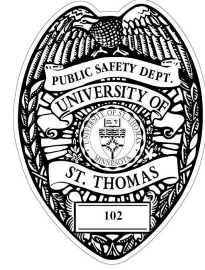

The Department of Public Safety would like to inform the St. Thomas community about two Motor Vehicle Thefts on and near the St. Paul campus. These incidents occurring within one month of each other exhibit a possible pattern that someone could be targeting the St. Paul campus area to commit Motor Vehicle Thefts.

On February 27th, 2025, a St. Thomas student living off campus on the 2100 block of Grand Avenue reported that their vehicle was stolen out of their apartment's parking lot between 10:00 AM and 6:00 PM.

The second incident occurred on campus. A St. Thomas student reported their vehicle was stolen while it was parked on the south side of Selby Avenue, near the intersection of Selby Ave and Finn St. This Motor Vehicle Theft occurred between March 16<sup>th</sup>, 2025 and March 21<sup>st</sup>, 2025.

We do not have any suspect information to share at this time.

As part of our ongoing commitment to community safety, we would like to remind everyone of the following crime prevention tips:

- Park your vehicle in well-lit areas.
- Always lock your vehicle.
- Do not leave any valuable items in your vehicle.
- Immediately report any suspicious activity or crimes to Public Safety or local law enforcement.
- If you see something, say something.
