Executive Summary – Key Highlights

At the beginning of April our team finished a multitude of items preparing for the groundbreaking of the Lee and Penny Anderson Arena. Trade partner, Bolander, began and completed the demolition of the Service Center and the McCarthy Gymnasium as well as the drilled piers next to the Facilities and Design Center. Ryan Self Perform Work started installation of footings and foundations and also poured the first elevator pad S05. Central Roofing waterproofed the elevator pad. On 4-15-24 two neighborhood groups filed an appeal on the final site plan approval causing work to immediately stop on all permitted construction activities under the site plan.











