

Jane M Klausman Women in Business Scholarship

The Jane M. Klausman Women in Business Scholarship program helps women pursue undergraduate and master's degrees in business management and overcome gender barriers from the classroom to the boardroom. The program operates at the Zonta club, district/region and international levels. Zonta annually awards up to 32 scholarships of \$2,000 each at the district/region level and six international scholarships in the amount of \$8,000 each.

Eligibility: Women of any age, pursuing a business or business-related program who demonstrate outstanding potential in the field and are living or studying in a Zonta district/region, are eligible. Students must be enrolled full-time in at least the second year of an undergraduate program through the final year of a Master's program at the time the application is submitted to the local Zonta club. Applicants must be in school at the time the scholarship funds are disbursed and must not graduate before December 2019.

Deadline: July 1, 2020

Lavon H Cooper Scholarship

This scholarship is for graduates of Robbinsdale District 281, Robbinsdale, MN. Students must have completed at least two consecutive semesters of post-secondary school education and have a GPA of 3.0 or better. The scholarship range is \$300 - \$1000. The district includes the cities of Robbinsdale, New Hope, Plymouth, Brooklyn Park, Crystal, Golden Valley, and Brooklyn Center, all in Minnesota.

Business Research Guide Scholarship for Women Entrepreneurs

This scholarship is designed to support promising women entrepreneurs as they pursue a higher education degree. Awardee will be selected based on the strength of their written business plan as determined by the scholarship committee at Business Research Guide. Applicants must submit a written business plan of 500-1000 words. The plan must be 100% original. One scholarship each award cycle in the amount of \$1000.

Eligibility: Available to U.S. citizens who have been accepted to or are enrolled at an accredited college or university in the U.S. Available to undergraduate and master's students in all majors and disciplines, with particular consideration given to women studying entrepreneurship, business management, or a closely related field.

Deadline: July 15, 2020

Wells Fargo Veterans Emergency Grants

An unexpected financial setback can be a major disruption on the path to a degree. The Wells Fargo Veterans Emergency Grants are designed to help U.S. military veterans who are enrolled in postsecondary education meet their household expenses, ensuring that they are able to stay in school without creating undue financial hardship for themselves or their families. The Wells Fargo Veterans Emergency Grant Program makes immediate grants available to eligible veterans who are pursuing a postsecondary degree and who experience financial difficulties. One-time grants up to \$1,000 will be awarded on an ongoing basis while funds are available; grant amounts will be determined based on the cost of the emergency need.
