1. Why should a parent take part in your programming?

The Selim Center offers lifelong learning opportunities that don't require the commitment of a full class registration such as the Parents on Campus program. Our programs include single sessions, and short series (up to 6 weeks in length, meeting once a week), making it flexible to meet the learning needs and interests of our learners, and especially parents of our St. Thomas students. We also offer a live, online simulcast for those unable to make it to campus for our programs so you can take part from anywhere in the world.

2. What is the cost?

Our programs range in cost from \$25 to \$150, depending on duration and type. Some of our programs include meal service, and the registration cost of those programs includes meal service.
