#YouAreWelcomeHere Scholarship Application

The #YouAreWelcomeHere scholarship recognizes promising international students with a vision for enhancing intercultural understanding. The University of St. Thomas will award two annual, renewable scholarships covering 50% of tuition. Please submit this scholarship application to international@stthomas.edu.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Demonstrate interest and personal initiative in activities involving intercultural learning and exchange.
- Be a first-year international applicant to the University of St. Thomas. An international applicant is an individual who holds citizenship in a country outside the USA and is in the USA with a visa, or intends to enter the USA with a visa.
- Attend (or have graduated from) a secondary school outside of the United States.

Application Process:

1. Apply for admission to the University of St. Thomas.
2. Submit the one-page #YouAreWelcomeHere application by January 15th, 2020.
3. If awarded a scholarship, claim it by submitting a tuition deposit by May 1st, 2020.
Note: The scholarship is open to students of all academic majors and fields of study.
