

# 2026-2027 HOUSING TOURS

**Tours run from 6 p.m. until 8 p.m.**

## Tour Guidelines:

- No parents or outside guests may tour, you may refer them to our website to see spaces.
- You may choose to tour as many or as few spaces as you like. It is possible to see all spaces offered for tours over the course of one evening.
- Tours will run continuously in all halls except for mid-campus; see below for where you should go for each hall. Head directly to the hall(s) you want to see; you do not need to check-in at the Residence Life Office for tours.
- You will need your St. Thomas ID card to access each hall.

## Flynn Hall Apartments and Suites

- Enter from the patio and meet in the Flynn Lobby by the desk

## Frey Hall Suites

- Use the entrance nearest the chapel and meet in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor Lobby by the desk

## Grace Hall Suites

- Use either the west or east entrance and meet in the Grace Basement by the desk

## Morrison Hall Apartments

- Take the elevator to the Morrison 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor or enter via the skyway and meet by the desk

## 2085, 2151, and 2171/75 Grand Avenue Apartments (Mid-Campus)

- Tours start every 30 minutes on the :00 and :30 of each hour; if you are late, you will be asked to wait until the next tour starts, the last tour will start at 8:00pm
- Head to 2085 Grand Avenue (right behind McNeely) room 104 (student lounge) to start the tour
