2024-2025 Housing Reapplication Process for Upper Division Returning Students

STEP 1. BEGIN BY LOGGING INTO MUPHY ONLINE AND NAVIGATE TO STUDENT HOUSING PORTAL.

- Log into Murphy Online through the St. Thomas homepage or going directly to <u>https://banner.stthomas.edu</u>.
- Once logged in, select the Student Services link from the main page.
- At the bottom of the Student Services page, select the link for Student Housing System.
- On the Student Housing page, select the link that will bring you to the St. Thomas Housing System and it will open a new browser window/tab with the Student Housing Portal.

Housing Reapplication, Lottery, Selection Process and Waitlist:

- November 6 Housing Reapplication opens for Upper-Division Student Housing Selection (current second-year, junior and senior students)
- December 8 Deadline to apply for Upper-Division Student Housing Selection to participate in lottery process
- December 12 Selection times sent to students based on lottery process
- December 13 Upper-Division Student Housing Selection begins (students self-select into their hall and room, and can select/pull in roommate/s)
- December 14 Housing selection continues based on available spaces, or sign up to be on waitlist.

Roommate Group PIN

Are you planning on living with roommates on-campus?

During the housing selection process you will need a Roommate PIN (Personal Identification Number) if another student plans to pull you in to a space on campus. We recommend (but do not require) that all students in a Roommate Group select the same PIN to simplify the pull-in process. Because our system is lottery based, you may not know which of your set of roommates will need to pull-in the remaining roommates, so all students in a group should set a PIN to be prepared.

Set your Roommate Group PIN below and then share it with the student who has your permission to pull you into a space on campus. You will receive a confirmation email after a student pulls you in to a space.

If you are not prepared to set a PIN number at this time, or want to change your PIN later after you have identified a group of roommates, you will be able to change your PIN on the applications landing page of the housing portal. (If you change your PIN, the other roommates in your group do not have to change their PIN).

Set Up Your Roommate PIN Here!

- You can reset your PIN at any time, so if you forget it, just click the Roommate Group PIN button found on the Residence Life landing page to access the form and reset and re-submit a new PIN.
- The PIN can be any length between 4-10 digits long. We recommend using 4 digits.
