StepUP® helps college students champion lives of recovery, achieve academic success, and thrive in a community of accountability and support. If you are enrolled at any college or university in the Twin Cities or in an accredited online university, you are eligible for our residential recovery program at Augsburg University.

>> HOW IT WORKS

Non-Augsburg students interested in joining StepUP must fill out an application form and submit two letters of recommendation. These forms can be found on our website, **augsburg.edu/stepup**. StepUP fees for non-Augsburg students are \$1,500 per semester plus housing costs for those who choose to live on campus.

>> WHAT YOU GET

StepUP students benefit from comprehensive support including housing in a substance-free residence hall on Augsburg's campus, individualized care with licensed counselors focused on recovery and academic success, and a strong community of other college students in recovery. Students who choose to not live on campus can still attend events and access resources.
