This document is designed for Normandale Community College students completing the English Transfer Pathway A.A. with the intent to transfer to the University of St. Thomas and complete the English B.A. degree. Students who do not intend to complete the 60-credit degree should contact our <u>transfer admission team</u> to plan course selections for the major and the goal areas.

All English majors should complete 44 credits in English and maintain a GPA of 2.0 in English. Students should take 16 credits in literature, chosen from the following: 211, 212, 214, 215, 217, 218, 220, 221, 222, 297, 324, 325, 327, 334, 337, 341, 360, 361, 362, 364, 365, 366, 367, 370, 371, 372, 373, 390, and 395.

ENGL 201, 202, 203, or 204 may be taken as ENGL elective credit if all other major requirements are met.

A minimum of 16 credits in English at or above ENGL 211 must be taken at St. Thomas
