The Office of Study Abroad (OSA) manages a portfolio of scholarships for those students participating in approved OSA off-campus programs. All students are encouraged to apply, even if their approval for a program is not yet confirmed. The general scholarship application ensures that applicants are considered for every scholarship for which they are eligible.

To apply, please visit our website www.stthomas.edu/studyabroad and follow all instructions carefully.

Minimum requirements to receive study abroad scholarships:

- Degree-seeking student at the University of St. Thomas
- Good academic and disciplinary standing
- Approval to participate in a study abroad program

Tips for completing the general scholarship application:

- Read through the list of OSA scholarships and review all eligibility requirements.
- Begin an application and review the essay questions. You can save your application and log back in to edit it.
- Write well thought out essays, and address particular scholarships for which you would like to be considered.

NOTE: Applicants may receive only one award per year from those listed within this portfolio. Students who qualify for tuition remission are not eligible to receive any of the scholarships in this portfolio. All scholarship award amounts are subject to change based upon available funds.

BRAND NEW SCHOLARSHIPS!

Incoming First-Year Student Scholarship (J-TERM)

Incoming first-year students are eligible to participate in J-Term abroad during their first year at St. Thomas but arrive on-campus long after the date for J-Term scholarships has passed (April 10). OSA has reserved funding for two (2) scholarships for incoming first-year J-Term 2020 study abroad with a later deadline of September 6, 2019.

Award amount: \$1,000 (x2)

Eligibility Requirements:

- Undergraduate degree-seeking student at St. Thomas
- Incoming first-year student
- Participation in J-Term study abroad program during first year at St. Thomas
- Financial need

DFC Alumni Scholarship (ANY TERM)

Graduates of Dougherty Family College (DFC) matriculating into a 4-year program at St. Thomas are encouraged to study abroad. OSA has set aside funding for DFC J-Term scholarships with a later deadline of September 6, 2019. Applications for all other terms follow the normal scholarship deadlines.

Award amount: \$1,000

Eligibility Requirements:

- Undergraduate degree-seeking student at St. Thomas
- Dougherty Family College (DFC) alum
- Financial need

SEMESTER and ACADEMIC YEAR SCHOLARSHIPS

Garhart-Tenney Scholarship (SEMESTER or YEAR)

This scholarship honors the memory of Professor Robert Garhart, St. Thomas Economics faculty from 1981-1999. Donors Patrick and Marny Tenney state: "We look to inspire business and economics students to develop a global understanding and to do so by experiencing the world and its people first hand." Award amount: \$1,000-\$2,500

Eligibility Requirements:

- Undergraduate degree-seeking student majoring in Business or Economics
- Minimum 3.0 GPA

Global Semesters Scholarship (SEMESTER)

OSA is committed to supporting diverse global study. This scholarship is for students participating in study abroad programs outside of Europe. Award amount: \$2,500

Eligibility Requirements:

- Undergraduate degree-seeking student at St. Thomas participating in semester study abroad program outside of Europe
- Agree to post social media updates and photos of intercultural activities and learning opportunities while abroad and participate in OSA events and promotion upon return
- Academic excellence
- Financial need

Keri Kohut Memorial Scholarship (SEMESTER)

Keri Kohut spent the 1991-92 academic year at the University of Lancaster in England and worked in the International Education Center at St. Thomas as a study abroad peer advisor upon her return. She was passionate in her commitments to social justice and global issues. She passed away in 2005 and is dearly missed. Award amount: \$5,000 fall, \$5,000 spring

Eligibility Requirements:

- Undergraduate degree-seeking Junior during the year of the award
- Student majoring in Psychology, Social Work or Justice and Peace Studies
- Minimum 3.0 GPA
- Financial need

London Business Semester Scholarship (FALL)

London Business Semester (LBS) is a Fall semester study abroad program for students majoring or minoring in Business. If you are approved for LBS, apply for this scholarship! Award amount: up to \$2,000

- Academic excellence
- Financial need

The Thomas Scholarships (SEMESTER)

These merit scholarships fund undergraduate students majoring in Education, Engineering, Natural Sciences and Social Work.

Award amount: \$1,000- \$2,500

Eligibility Requirements

- Minimum 2.75 GPA (individual study abroad programs may require higher GPA)
- Student majoring in Education, Engineering, Natural Sciences or Social Work
- Leadership in academics, student life or service
- Upon return to St. Thomas, student will agree to participate in the Study Abroad Fair, and in activities which support international exchange-

JANUARY TERM SCHOLARSHIPS

Roberta Ann Mundschenk Endowed Global J-Term Scholarship (J-TERM)

Roberta Mundschenk and her children's purpose in creating this scholarship was to open up a world of experiences to as many deserving students as possible. Preference is given to the student traveling to a country not visited by any past recipient. Award amount: 50% study abroad program tuition, plus 10% of the award amount as a stipend.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Full-time degree-seeking student
- Cumulative 3.0 GPA, or 3.5 GPA obtained in the most recent semester/period
- Agree to purchase spoon for global spoon collection housed in the Office of Study Abroad

The AWE J-Term Annual Scholarship (J-TERM)

Award amount: \$1,000-\$2,500

Eligibility Requirements:

- Course of study is the Humanities, including disciplines such as Art, Architecture, Theatre, Cultural Studies or Literature
- Financial need

The 2005 Senior Class Scholarship (J-TERM)

Award amount: \$1,000 (x2)

Eligibility Requirements:

- Undergraduate degree-seeking Senior
- First-time study abroad participant

Class of 2011 J-Term Study Abroad Scholarship (J-TERM)

Preference given to a first-time study abroad participant and/or to a student who holds a job. Award amount: \$1,000-\$2,500

Eligibility Requirements:

- Undergraduate degree-seeking student
- Financial need
- In the scholarship application essay, the student will detail their vision for giving back to St. Thomas as an alum and address why they think it is important.

Award amount: \$1,000-\$2,500

Eligibility Requirements:

- Undergraduate degree-seeking student

Eligibility Requirements:

- Financial need

Barbara and David Dougherty '65, Honorary OBE Annual Study Abroad Scholarship (ANY TERM)

Award amount: \$1,000-\$2,500

Eligibility Requirements:

- Financial need

Ed and Mary LeClair Study Abroad Scholarship for Music Majors (ANY TERM)

Music majors participating in any study abroad program for any term are eligible for this scholarship! Preference given to students with Junior year status while studying abroad. Award amount: \$1,000-\$2,500

Eligibility Requirements:

- Undergraduate degree-seeking student majoring in Music
- Minimum 2.8 GPA
- Financial need

German Study Abroad Scholarship (SEMESTER or J-TERM)

Preference given to student with Sophomore or Junior standing while studying abroad. First-year students are not eligible. Award amount: \$1,000 for semester, \$500 for J-Term

Eligibility Requirements:

- Undergraduate degree-seeking student majoring or minoring in German language
- Study abroad program in Germany
- Minimum 3.0 GPA

IES Europe Study Abroad Scholarship (SEMESTER OR SUMMER)

In 1949, Paul Koutny attended St. Thomas as an Austrian exchange student. Four years later he founded IES, one of St. Thomas's most popular study abroad partners. In 2006, three IES Vienna alumni established the IES scholarship in memory of their classmate and fellow IES Vienna alumnus Dan Krakowski ('65). Although the scholarship is now open to all students on IES programs in Europe, preference is given to IES Vienna participants.

Award amount: \$2,500

Eligibility Requirements:

- Undergraduate degree-seeking student at St. Thomas participating in an IES Vienna or Europe semester or summer program
- Sophomore, Junior or Senior year while studying abroad

Kitty Havlik Endowed Scholarship (ANY TERM)

Award amount: \$1,000-\$2,500

Eligibility Requirements:

- Financial need

Longbottom Family Annual Scholarship (ANY TERM)

Award amount: \$1,000-\$2,500

Eligibility Requirements:

- Financial need

Michael Dixon Memorial Scholarship (ANY TERM)

This award provides funding for an undergraduate student to study abroad in Ireland. Award amount: \$1,000-\$2,500

Eligibility Requirements:

- Undergraduate degree-seeking student
- Study abroad program in Ireland
- Financial need

Modern & Classical Languages Study Abroad Endowed Scholarship (ANY TERM)

Preference for a student from a middle-income family. Award amount: \$1,000-\$2,500

Eligibility Requirements:

- Undergraduate degree-seeking student pursuing a degree in Modern & Classical Languages
- Sophomore, Junior, or Senior year while studying abroad
- Minimum 2.5 GPA

Students of Color Scholarship (ANY TERM)

OSA is committed to expanding access to study abroad. This award is for students of color to study abroad for any term.

Award amount: \$2,500

Eligibility Requirements:

- Undergraduate degree-seeking student at St. Thomas
- First-time study abroad participant

Study Abroad Annual Scholarship (ANY TERM)

This award is for any first-time study abroad participant. Award amount: up to \$2,000

Eligibility Requirements:

- First-time study abroad participant
- Academic excellence
- Financial need

Ronda Kanne International Scholarship (ANY TERM)

Established in honor of mothers that inspire their children to learn, to develop an understanding of other cultures, and to look at the world with an open mind. Award amount: \$1,000 (x1)

Eligibility Requirements:

- Undergraduate degree-seeking student majoring or minoring in Business
- Student studying abroad in a Latin American country (NOT Mexico or Spain)
- Financial need
